

The rainbird irrigation timer in the pump house is now set up for only 1 valve shown below (**valve/area 1**). Area 1 is circled in red (5 areas) which are all controlled by valve 1.

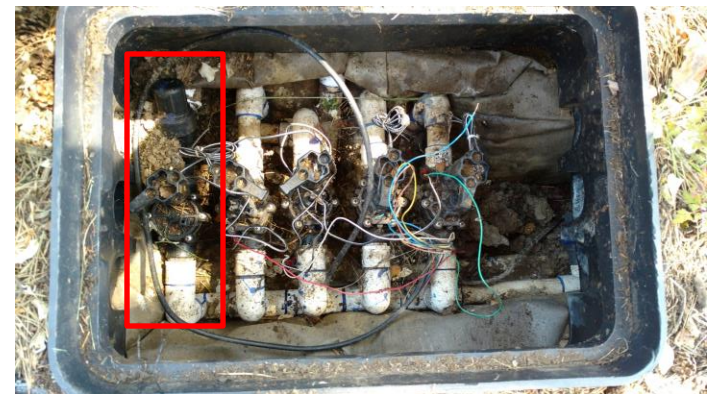
The timer is set up to go off at 1 AM and it waters all 5 areas simultaneously for 30 minutes, daily.

Area **1** by the drive way had two major leaks that have been fixed. The plants in that area should be getting adequate water.

The rainbird timer was once used to control a pump that pulled water from the river and water many areas in the upland grass areas. None of those pumps nor valves are connected to the pump house.

The area by the top left of the ramp (**garden area**) is watered by a battery driven timer. It waters both horse troughs and the ferns/rhodies/small trees. It waters at 10 PM for 20 minutes, daily.
